The Dominion Players of Lafayette, Indiana will present a brand-new play, in which we find Martin Luther and Katie, along with *The Adversary* and *The Advocate*, grappling with questions of Luther's life and legacy. The play runs at 6:30, 7:30, and 8:30 in the Sanctuary. The Exhibit Hall is open all evening and may be browsed at your leisure.

Participate in "The University" by entering a project or display about something you've learned regarding the Reformation! There are five age categories and prizes for the winner of each. See our website for more information.

Reformation Day Festival is **FREE** and open to the public. Donations accepted. The facility is completely handicap-accessible. Children are welcome to sit with their parents during the drama, and a "Family Room" with closed-circuit TV showing the play is available in case little ones get restless. A mothers-only "Nursing Room" with one-way glass to the Sanctuary is also available. An ASL Interpreter will be present.
